Accident & Emergency Plan

First Aid

A first aid kit is available in support of all work or events undertaken on the Fen on behalf of the Boughton Fen Committee (BFC). In the event of an accident or emergency basic first aid will be administered.

Notifying the Emergency Services

If deemed necessary the emergency services will be notified. A mobile telephone will be available for this purpose and a member of the BFC will make contact with the emergency services by dialling 999.

Location

The emergency services will need to know the exact location of the Fen. This will be given through the use of map grid references:

Easting 571986, Northing 301830

and/or road references;

Intersection of the Oxborough Road and Stoke Road heading towards Eastmoor, just off the A134 signposted to Oxborough.

Special Instructions

If the casualty cannot be moved the emergency services must be informed that access to the Fen can only be made by a 4x4 vehicle or similar.

If the casualty can be moved or is able to walk on their own they will be taken to the Oxborough Road by a member of the BFC where they will await the arrival of the emergency services.

Other Responsibilities

Three persons, all wearing hi visibility jackets, will be asked to go to the major road intersections, the A134/Oxborough Road, the Oxborough Road/Oxborough Road 'fork' and the Oxborough Road/Stoke Road, to provide additional direction pointers to the emergency services to speed their arrival.
