BECOME A PARISH COUNCILLOR!

Do you want to make a difference in your community? Turn your ideas into actions and improve your local area?

If so WE NEED YOU!

Boughton Parish Council has vacancies for two Councillors.

What does a Parish Councillor do? The Parish Council looks after the village environment including the green and pond, the play area and the Fen. They work with the Borough and County Councils to make sure the village is maintained and improved. They can support local groups and organise village events. Councillors work together to make decisions for the benefit of the community.

Who can be a Councillor? You can apply to be a Councillor if:

You are over the age of 18;

You have lived, worked or owned property in Boughton for at least 12 months OR you live in Boughton and are a registered local elector;

You are a British citizen, an eligible Commonwealth citizen, a citizen of the Republic of Ireland, a qualifying EU citizen OR an EU citizen with retained rights.

You should be available to attend meetings every 2 months, usually held on the fourth Tuesday of odd numbered months (+ occasional extra meetings).
